Sub: Verification of documents (degrees) and internship completion certificates of Indian students passing out from Nepal regarding.

Dear Sir/Madam

Reference Medical Council's letters regarding verification of documents submitted by Indian Nationals possessing medical qualifications granted by overseas medical institutions and applying for registration to practice medicine in India. In this regard it is stated that all medical students applying for registration are being advised to get their medical degrees verified by the concerned universities in Nepal and thereafter get the same authenticated by the Consular Section of the Embassy of India. Hence, there would be no further need of the Medical Council referring back these cases to the Embassy for further verification.

2. In view of the above, it is requested that Medical Council of India and State Medical Council may instruct to all such applicants to get the verification of their degrees done on their own, as this would be easier and faster and would not cause any delay.
3. The Medical Councils may accept verification letter duly attested by the Mission to avoid unnecessarily documentation/delay without further re-verification. In case, Medical Council have any doubts they can contact the concern University directly.
