

Q Who can be registered with the Uttar Pradesh Medical Council?

A A citizen of India possessing basic medical qualification as per schedule of Medical Council of India can be registered on completion of requisite formalities.

Q What a registered doctor can perform?

A

- a.** Can hold office as physician or surgeon or any other office (by whatever designation called) in Government or in any institution maintained by a local or other authority;
- b.** Can practice medicine in State;
- c.** Can be entitled to sign or authenticate a medical or fitness certificate or any other certificate required by any law to be signed or authenticated by a duly qualified medical practitioner;
- d.** Can be entitled to give evidence at any inquest or in any court of law as an expert under section 45 of the Indian Evidence Act, 1872 on any matter relating to medicine.

Q Whether a person possessing basic qualification MBBS can practice in all disciplines?

A An MBBS doctor is not debarred from practicing to any branch of medicine under the present Bengal Medical Act 1914 provided the candidate has sufficient exposure in the branch and/or in the particular discipline to gain proficiency and/or confidence in dealing with such cases belonging to discipline concerned. However, considering medico legal aspect, it is necessary to have a degree/diploma in the particular subject for independent practice.

Q Who is a specialist doctor?

A A doctor who possess postgraduate diploma or degree in a particular discipline/branch can be treated as ‘Specialist’ in that discipline / branch.

What are the means of recognized medical qualification ?	<p>As per Section 2 (d) In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires, -"recognize medical qualification" means –</p> <p>(i) any of the medical qualification for the time being, included in the schedules to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 (No.102 of 1956);</p> <p>(ii) any of the medical qualifications specified in the schedule;</p> <p>Without State Medical Council Registration, it is not allowed to do any kind of medical practice/ job.</p> <p>Doctors registered with M.C.I. also need to get State Medical Registration, where he/she intends to practice. Multiple State Medical Registrations are possible if one intends to practice in multiple states.</p>

Why registration is compulsory for allopathic medical practice in the state of Uttar Pradesh?	<p>As per the provisions of section 21 no person in the territory of Uttar Pradesh is entitled to practice in the system of modern scientific medicine (allopathy) directly or indirectly without getting prior medical registration of his /her medical qualification(s) under Uttar Pradesh Medical Council or the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.</p> <p>As per the provisions laid down in section 11(3) and section 13(1) of Uttar Pradesh only those recognized medical qualifications medical degrees / diploma / certificates) can be registered with the Uttar Pradesh Medical Council that have been duly recognized under Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 and included in the Indian Medical Council Schedule of the recognized medical qualification.</p> <p>Medical registration of each recognized medical qualification (P.G. degree / diploma obtained subsequently after the initial registration of MBBS) has been made mandatory vide section 13 (1) of the Uttar Pradesh Medical Council to every registered medical practitioner to use such additional qualification (as Additional Registration specialist of the subject) for the purpose of practice or any other purpose whatever or derive any advantage there from during the course of practice or the purpose of employment</p> <p>Necessary provisions of penalty and imprisonment have also been made in Uttar Pradesh Medical Council for the persons who shall practice in allopathic medicine (Modern System of Medicine) in the state without</p>
